

Community Nursery Nurse Clinic

Community Nursery Nurses hold development review clinics in our family hubs. These clinics enable you to discuss your child's development, health and you own wellbeing. Additionally, it is a chance for your child to have their growth measurements taken.



Our work with local Foodbanks

Our Family Hubs work closely with the Franche foodbank to help those within our community access food. Franche food bank can provide a 6-week delivery for those in need or can't leave the house for any reason.

Any vouchers issued are sent via email unless you do not have access to email, then we would print them off for collection.





Pregnant women, women with a child under 12 months and children aged up to 4 years who are receiving Healthy Start vouchers are entitled to free Healthy Start vitamins.



Healthy Start vitamins are important because:

- 8% of children under 5 in the UK do not have enough vitamin A in their diet
- All pregnant and breastfeeding women and young children are at risk of vitamin D deficiency (teenagers, younger women and those from ethnic minorities are particularly at risk).

Healthy Start vitamins contain vitamins A, C and D for children aged from birth to 4 years, and folic acid and vitamins C and D for pregnant and breastfeeding women.



Healthy Start vitamins are available to purchase from both our hubs!

Women's Vitamins - 91p Children's vitamin drops -£1.80



We accept Healthy Start Vouchers! To check if you meet the criteria for free vouchers and help to apply, please scan the OR code!

The vitamins are suitable for vegetarians and free from milk, egg, gluten, soya and peanut residues, and have a shelf life of 15 months from manufacture. Beneficiaries are entitled to 1 bottle of children's drops every 8 weeks.




